**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD BY THE LYNN WATER & SEWER  
COMMISSION CONCERNING ITS PROPOSED INFILTRATION/INFLOW FEE IN THE CITY  
OF LYNN WHICH IS PROPOSED TO BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON AN APPROVED DATE  
AND ADOPTION BY THE LYNN WATER & SEWER COMMISSION**

Pursuant to Chapter 381 of the Acts of 1982 Section 7 (a) the Lynn Water & Sewer Commission will hold a public hearing at 6:00 p.m. on March 8, 2017, at 400 Parkland Avenue, Lynn, Massachusetts, for the purpose of giving interested persons an opportunity to present data, views, or arguments relative to the following schedule of rates to become effective per the Commission adoption.

Proposed Infiltration/Inflow fee: Four times an amount of \$1.16 per gallon for developments that are proposing to discharge more than 15,000 gallons of sanitary sewage per day into the LWSC sanitary sewer system.

As required by 314 CMR 12.04(2) and Civil Action No. 76-CV-02184 RGS, United States of America and Commonwealth of Massachusetts vs. Lynn Water & Sewer Commission, in order to mitigate impacts from any new connections or extensions to the sewer system with design flows of greater than 15,000 gallons per day, removal of four (4) gallons of infiltration and inflow for each gallon of new flow to be generated by the new connection or extension is required.

Within 15 business days of the date of the publication of this notice, any member of the public may submit a signed letter to the Executive Director of the Commission at 400 Parkland Avenue, Lynn, Massachusetts, stating his views, arguments, or data concerning the issues to be considered at the hearing. If any member of the public desires to submit written materials in support of any data, views, or arguments he intends to present at the hearing, he shall, within 15 business days of the publication of this notice, submit such materials to the Executive Director of the Commission, at the address set forth above, accompanied by a signed letter setting forth the nature of the accompanying materials, the fact that he desires to use to support data, views, and arguments he intends to present at the hearing. Submissions may be mailed or delivered in person during the normal business hours of the Commission and will be deemed to have been submitted when received by the Commission.
