The Summer Recycling IQ Inspectors will work in a team on the Recycling IQ Program, a grant funded program of the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection that aims to Improve the Quality of local recycling programs through a two pronged approach: education and feedback at the curbside.

**Responsibilities:**

- Inspect recycling carts at the curbside for proper recycling contents
- Tag and record recycling carts that do not contain proper recycling contents
- Educate residents at the curbside on trash and recycling rules for the curbside cart program

**Qualifications:**

- Passion for the environment and a desire to make a difference in the city of Lynn
- Ability to work with people from a variety of different ethnic, socio-economic, educational, religious, sexual and generational backgrounds
- Ability to deal with residents and businesses participating in the curbside collection program, and with the general public
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions and to communicate both orally and in writing
- Ability to stand; walk; sit; use hands to finger, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl; talk or hear; and taste or smell.
- Ability to occasionally lift up to 50 pounds.
- Ability to use close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus.

You must be a resident of Lynn to apply for this position. This position is open to U.S. citizens, nationals, or lawful permanent resident aliens age 18 and older.
