

NOTICE OF CHANGE IN SPECIAL ELECTION

On March 13, 2017, the Honorable Justice Peter Lauriet, Essex Superior Court (Salem, Massachusetts) in the matter In Re: City of Lynn Civil Docket Number 340-17C granted the City of Lynn's Motion to cancel the Special Election regarding the proposed construction of two new middle schools as a result of public safety concerns with respect to a major snowstorm which was predicted for March 14, 2017. The Court requested that the Lynn City Council select a new date for the Special Election. On Monday March 13, 2017 and Wednesday, March 15, 2017, the Lynn City Council voted to reschedule the special election for **Tuesday March 21, 2017** pending the approval of Justice Lauriet. On Thursday, March 16, 2017, Judge Lauriet approved the new date for the election which will now occur on **Tuesday March 21, 2017**. The Court Order stated that all votes previously cast in anticipation of the cancelled election shall be tabulated and counted. The Court Order also extended absentee voting through March 20, 2017 at 12:00 p.m. All polling locations remain unchanged.
